In addition to raising funds for the BPC, we will be donating a percentage of these funds to Roots & Shoots, a program of the Jane Goodall Institute. Roots & Shoots is a powerful, youth-driven, global network of more than 8,000 groups in almost 100 countries. Together, youth of all ages are taking action to improve our world through service learning projects that promote care and concern for animals, the environment and the human community.
